 Measuring inequality involves making comparisons across the entire distribution of income, not just the poor. One way of doing this is to divide the population into groups, like quintiles, and then calculate what share of income is received by each group. An alternative approach is to draw Lorenz curves, which compare the cumulative income actually received to a perfectly equal distribution of income. Income inequality in the United States increased substantially from the late 1970s and early 1980s into the 2000s. The two most common explanations cited by economists are changes in the structure of households that have led to more two-career couples and single-parent families, and the effect of new information and communications technology on wages.

Flint's Water Crisis Fits a Pattern of Environmental Injustice

Flint's Water Crisis Fits a Pattern of Environmental Injustice

Flint, Michigan, recently found itself under emergency management in the wake of budgetary problems. To save money, the city moved water from the heavily polluted Flint River instead of Lake Huron, diverting the many health concerns of citizens. Journalist Curt Gispette exposed this story in national attention, and now Flint is finally on the road to recovery. The episode is a cautionary tale for municipalities considering unethical ways to save money at the expense of public health.

By now, the consequences of the disastrous decision to shift the source of the city of Flint's water supply are well known. The public outcry generated by almost daily headline coverage of the crisis has led to some urgent and essential actions—such as distributing bottled water and monitoring children exposed to high levels of lead—as well as conversations about the need for a permanent solution. But for that solution to be a meaningful and lasting one, we need to look back to the roots of the problem.

species that could benefit from increased disease resistance. Major diseases affecting chickens include avian influenza, Newcastle, and Marek's disease.

Disease-resistant Genetically Engineered Animals

While selection for disease resistance in livestock species might prove to be a powerful tool for livestock producers, it is limited by the natural genetic variation present in the species being selected. Genetic engineering, on the other hand, allows for the introduction of novel genetic sequences into the species of interest and is not limited by species barriers or the genetic building blocks in all species are the same. The use of genetic engineering has long been suggested as a method to increase disease resistance in livestock, and scientists are currently working on a number of different animal models which could be used to help livestock resist infection (Table 1).

Spongiform encephalopathies, such as scrapie in sheep and Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE) also known as "Mad Cow Disease" in cattle are neurodegenerative diseases caused by the misfolding of a protein called PrP. BSE has been linked to the human neurodegenerative disease called variant Creutzfeldt-Jakob disease.¹⁰ "And so this is a potential threat to human health. In a procedure known as prion knock-out, scientists can target a specific gene in an organism and remove it. This technology was successfully used to "knock-out" the gene which codes for the prion protein in goats, sheep, and cattle."¹¹ In addition to generating livestock which are free from the threat of spongiform encephalopathies, these animals could be used as "spare parts" for some ethical products for use in human medicine. Transgenic goats carrying antibodies that express sRNA against the prion protein have been reported.¹² sRNA is a sequence-specific method to selectively block down endogenous gene expression. It works by interfering transgenic lentiviruses double-stranded gene constructs which enable the stable expression of small interfering (siRNA) that constitutively suppress target gene expression.¹³
