

# Most Common Non-English Language Spoken at Home

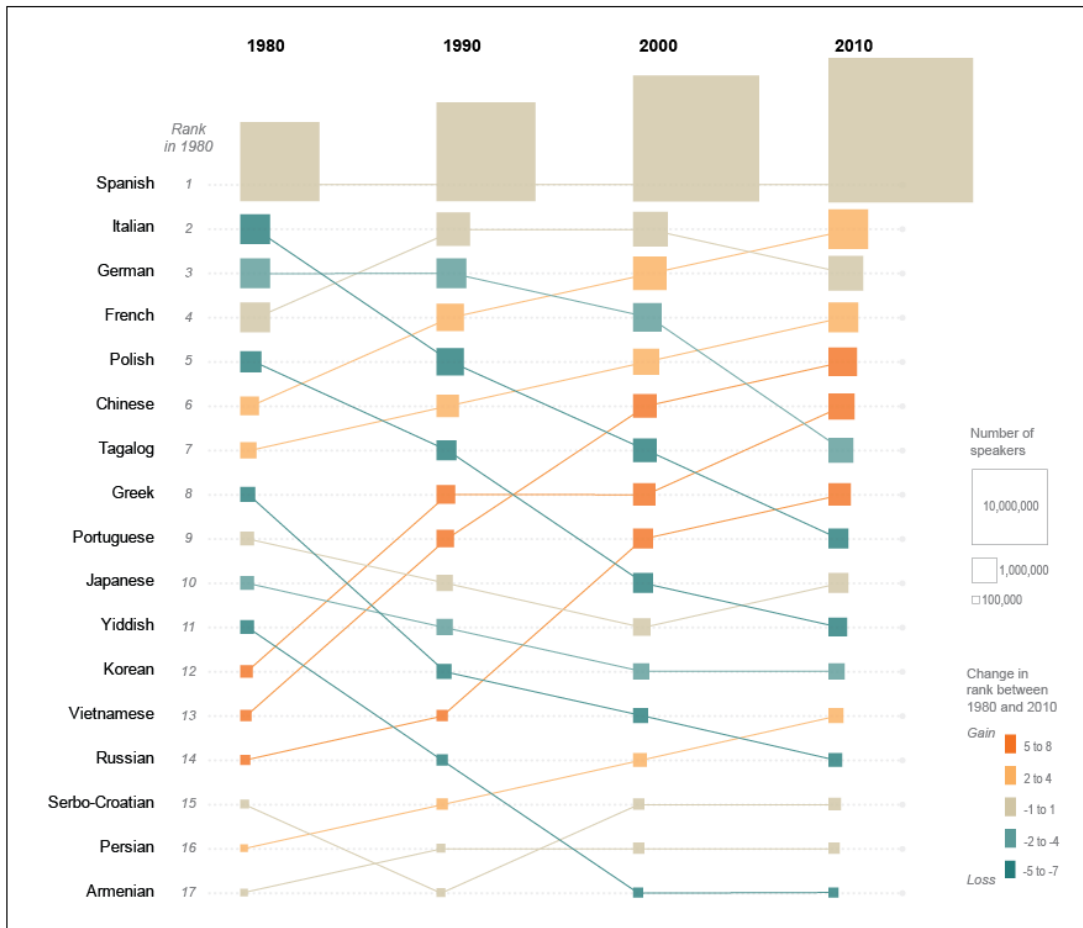
## Based On US 2012 Census

- According to the most recent U.S. Census estimates, there are well over **17 million Asian-Americans** in the United States.
- Most Asian languages are **on the rise**. After English, Chinese is #2, Tagalog is #4, Vietnamese is #5 and Korean is #6.
